IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR OUR CUSTOMERS

Warrant of Fitness (WoF) & Certificate of Fitness (CoF) Inspections

Vehicle Testing New Zealand Limited (VTNZ) has been appointed by the NZ Transport Agency (NZTA) to carry out WoF & CoF inspections to requirements set by NZTA. WoF & CoF inspections only cover items required by legislation to ensure a vehicle is safe when on New Zealand roads. NZTA reserves the right to recheck any vehicle. Items such as engine & gearbox condition are not checked. It's the owner's responsibility to ensure the vehicle is maintained to a WoF or CoF level at all times. Please present the vehicle in a clean state for its inspection.

WoF & CoF inspections include, amongst other items, the following safety checks: tyre condition, windscreen washers, speedometer, brake operation & wipers, steering & suspension, structural condition, doors, exhaust, lights, safety belts, fuel systems, glazing, & airbags (if fitted).

VTNZ accepts no responsibility for defective items which aren't detected during a WoF or CoF inspection carried out in accordance with NZTA inspection requirements & with reasonable care & skill.

WoF & CoF Rerechecks

Rerechecks must happen within 28 days of the original inspection. Otherwise a new inspection must be done & a new fee paid. Rerechecks are available at all VTNZ branches. You don't have to take the vehicle back to the original branch. WoF rerechecks are **FREE** within 28 days of the original inspection. A CoF rerecheck fee may be charged depending on the number of rerecheck items. VTNZ reserves the right to fully re-inspect a vehicle & charge a full inspection fee.

Full Safety & Safety Essentials Inspections

These safety checks aren't intended as a substitute for a WoF inspection. The Safety Essentials Inspection covers 16 things that are the most common causes of accidents like your brakes, tyres, lights & steering. The Full Safety Inspection includes everything covered in the Safety Essentials Inspection, plus 24 extra things like the suspension, engine/drive train & fuel system, the vehicle structure & interior.

Vehicle Condition Assessments – not intended as a substitute for a full mechanical or CoF inspection.

Basic Service – not intended as a substitute for a full mechanical inspection.

All Inspections

If this inspection isn't a Pre-Purchase Assessment then it's not intended to be one. It's the responsibility of a purchaser to ascertain the vehicle condition before purchasing it. VTNZ strongly recommends you get a vehicle assessed before purchasing. Our Pre-Purchase Assessment service is available at most branches.

VTNZ isn't responsible for & doesn't accept liability for any loss, either direct or indirect, caused by VTNZ's failure to identify any defects, apparent or inherent, in vehicles or their components where those defects aren't visually apparent when an inspection is carried out in accordance with inspection methods issued by VTNZ. For example, VTNZ will not be responsible for failing to detect defects in mechanical components such as engines & transmissions. In VTNZ's view, the structural integrity of a vehicle cannot be ascertained without removal of panels. Unless this is requested by the customer, VTNZ accepts no responsibility for structural defects not detected during this inspection.
